



A Fairy Tale Setting for Your Summer Holiday

West Wales is an idyllic holiday destination, and Godremamog Water Mill offers the perfect getaway retreat. This beautiful old building was built in 1885 and, although it was used for many years as a working mill, families have now been holidaying there for around 40 years. Many people who first visited as children in the 1970s still go today, taking their own children with them.

The mill itself is situated on the border of Pembrokeshire and Carmarthenshire, and is ideally set in a secluded woodland valley along the path of a mountain stream. Inside, the mill has been converted into four spacious self-catering apartments, each sleeping three to four people. For larger parties or for family get togethers, all four apartments can be hired together, accommodating up to 15 people.

The scenic valley makes an appearance in the Mabinogion, a 14th Century collection of Welsh folk tales which records magical events happening in the Cych Valley. Many guests today say that they can still feel something enchanting in the area.

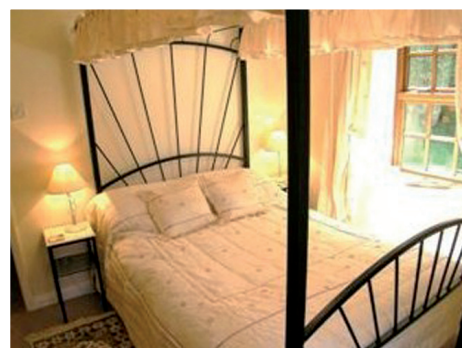
The gardens surrounding the mill are home to a variety of wildlife. Sam and Chris Hogarth, who have looked after the mill since 2005, have taken care to minimise their impact on this beautiful environment.

While the area is unarguably peaceful, if you stay at Godremamog you're guaranteed not to run out of fun things to do. The region, with its unrivalled scenery, is a particular favourite with ramblers. There are a number of walks which begin right at the mill, and it is also the perfect base to head out into South and West Wales and spend the day exploring the stunning beaches and mountains.

However long you stay in these amazing apartments, with so much to do in the area, we can guarantee that you'll wish you could stay for longer! The Pembrokeshire coastal path is just a 30 minute drive away, and the spectacular views on offer here are unparalleled. There are a number of fishing spots nearby, and for those of you who prefer something a little more active, bikes can be delivered directly to the mill for your use. If you're feeling brave, why not try some mountain biking in the Brechfa forest?

The activities on offer don't end there – during your stay you can try your hand at horse riding, golf, and bird watching. You might even find yourself coming home with a new hobby!

If you would like to spend a day a little closer to home, there is plenty to see and do in the grounds. There are few cars in the area, so the gardens can be enjoyed in peace. Families can have great fun playing in the river, and Sam and Chris have provided sun-loungers, garden furniture, and a barbeque for the enjoyment of their guests. Perfect for a sunny day!



All four apartments benefit from full central heating, and have all been awarded four stars. The wood effect stove and colour TV make the apartments the perfect place to relax after a long day. Everything you need to make your stay as hassle free as possible is included for you, right down to the coffee which you'll undoubtedly crave on your arrival!

Families are always welcome at the mill, and children will no doubt love visiting the nearby Chocolate Farm, the Steam Railway, or taking an exciting Safari Boat Trip! Information regarding local attractions can be asked for on arrival, or viewed on the website.

The building is steeped in history, something which is evident from the moment you lay eyes on it, and this fact is enhanced by the sheer tranquillity of its setting.
